



Skills for Education and Employment

Are you registered as a job seeker? Do you want training that will give you the edge when applying for jobs?

You can complete training in anything from resumé writing to presenting in interviews.

or

Do you want assistance in getting you prepared for any future education?

You may just want help to learn how to complete everyday things; like filling out forms or doing your banking?

We have the answer! The Skills for Education and Employment (SEE) program, delivered by Bendigo TAFE, seeks to improve your language, literacy and numeracy skills to help you gain confidence in finding a job.

Training

The SEE program is delivered face-to-face on a part-time or full-time basis, providing up to 800 hours of free training. You can also participate in work experience or work placement as part of the SEE program.

Eligibility for referrals

If you are 15-64 years, an Australian citizen and registered as a job seeker, then you may be eligible for referral to the SEE program.
